### THE GREAT SIN OF PRIDE:

#### From the Proverbs:

"The fear of the LORD is to hate (1) evil; (2) pride and (3) arrogance and the (4) evil way and the (5) perverted mouth, I hate.  
Proverbs 8:13

When (cause) pride comes, then (effect) comes dishonor, but with the humble is wisdom.  
Proverbs 11:2

Everyone who is (what) proud in heart is an (what) abomination to (who) the LORD; assuredly, he will not be unpunished.  
Proverbs 16:5

Pride goes before (what) destruction, and a haughty spirit before (what) stumbling.  
Proverbs 16:18

Do you see a man (what) wise (where) in his own eyes? There is more hope for a fool than for him.  
Proverbs 26:12

A man's pride will (what) bring him low, but a humble spirit will obtain honor.

#### From the New Testament:

Now these things, brethren, I have figuratively applied to myself and Apollos for your sakes, so that in us you may learn not to exceed what is written, so that (what) no one of you will become arrogant in behalf of one against the other.

- (1) For who regards you as superior?
- (2) What do you have that you did not receive?
- (3) And if you did receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it?

### The first, great sin:

#### The Fall of Man:

When the woman (1) saw that the tree was (what) good for food, and that it was a (2) delight to the eyes, and that the tree was (3) desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the (1) lust of the flesh and the (2) lust of the eyes and the (3) boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. #### The Fall of Satan:

"How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, you who have weakened the nations! But you said in your heart,

- (1) 'I will ascend to heaven;
- (2) 'I will raise my throne above the stars of God, and
- (3) 'I will sit on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north.
- (4) 'I will ascend above the heights of the clouds;
- (5) 'I will make myself like the Most High.'

### THE GREAT BLESSING OF HUMILITY:

Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as (what) more important than yourselves; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for (what) the interests of others. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He (what) humbled Himself (how) by becoming obedient to (what extent) the point of death, even death on a cross. For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
